

Update checkboxes custom field if a file has been attached during a transition

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Features used to implement the example

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Example: Update checkboxes custom field if a file has been attached during a transition

I have a requirement to check that during a WKf transition at least a file was attached. If this is true, I need to update a Custom field (type checkbox).

Yes, you can do it using post-function [Set a field as a function of other fields](#). I will show you how to do it in an example where we have a **Checkbox** type custom field called "Colours", with various colours as options. We want to set color "red" if issue has at least one attachment, leaving unaffected (checked or unchecked) the rest of the colours:

Field to be checked for matching with type 1 setting rules:	Summary
	This field is only used by rules where conditional part is a regular expression written in brackets: <code>"(regular_expression)"value</code>
Target field to be set:	Colours - [Checkboxes]
	Field to be set by first matched setting rule. Type of the field is shown in square brackets. Check documentation on Virtual Fields to get information about suitable values for setting selected target field.
Setting rules: There are two types of setting rules, and both types can be combined in the same post-function. Rule formats: - type 1: <code>"(regular_expression)"value</code> - type 2: <code>"[boolean_expression]"value</code> Write only one rule per line. <i>value</i> may be a parsed text or a mathematical or time formula, depending on the type of selected <i>Target field</i> . Regular expression syntax	<pre>[[{00073}>0]+red</pre>
Numeric or Date-Time field values >	Number of attachments - [Number] - {00073} INSERT
Text-String field values >	Summary - [Text] - %00000 INSERT

Once configured, transition will look like this:

Conditions 0	Validators 0	Post Functions 7
<div> <div>The following will be processed after the transition occurs</div> <div>Add post function</div> </div>		
1. The field Colours will be set according to the evaluation of Summary against the following set of rules: [{Number of attachments}>0]+red		

As a clarification I explain that the '+' character preceding "red" is used to add (or check) the "red" option keeping the rest of options unaltered. If you wanted to uncheck it, you should use "-red". If you use "red" without + or -, you will uncheck all the options but "red". You have more examples of it in post-function [Copy parsed text to a field](#).

Field "Number of attachments" (field code {00073}) represents the number of attachments in the issue including those uploaded in transition screen. I have released a beta version 2.1.17_beta_1 with 2 new virtual fields: "Number of transition attachments" (field code {00135}) and "Transition's comment" (field code %{00127}).

You can use "Number of transition attachments" if you need to consider only those attachments uploaded in transition screen. Feel confident to use this beta version of the plugin in production environment, since it only differs from version 2.1.16 in those 2 new virtual fields.

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
