## Purpose

This condition is used for showing a transition only to those users in a field. This condition supports any **User** or **Multi-User** field or custom field.

Also **text fields** can be used. In these cases it's expected that fields contain the **name of a user** or a **comma separated list of user names**. Don't confuse **user name** with **users's full name**.

## Example: Limit transition visibility only to current issue watchers

Only user in field:

Watchers - [Multi-user]

Fields different from *User Picker*, *Multi-User Picker*, *Group Picker* or *Multi-Group Picker*, are expected to contain the **name of a user** (not to be confused with user's full name).

Once configured, condition will look like this:

Triggers 0

Conditions 1

Validators 1

Post Functions 8

All of the following conditions

Add condition

Only user in field **Watchers** is allowed to see and execute this transition.
