SINCE VERSION 2.7.0

This condition was introduced in version 2.7.0 and replaced the [A field is/isn't initialized \(deprecated\)](#) condition which had a limited subset of features.

## Purpose

Using this condition you can make sure that one or multiple **fields either need to have a value or be empty** in order to execute a transition. The following options are available:

- A field **is required**.
- A field **must be empty**.

For **cascading select** fields **both levels** are being considered and need to have / not have a value.
