

# escapeHTML()

This function **replaces** special **characters** with **HTML** entities.

### Syntax

escapeHTML(text) #Output: Text

### Examples

| Parser expression              | Description                                                         |
|--------------------------------|---------------------------------------------------------------------|
| escapeHTML("<Français>" )      | This example returns:<br><b>&amp;lt;Fran&amp;ccedil;ais&amp;gt;</b> |
| escapeHTML("JWT & Jira = <3" ) | This example returns:<br><b>JWT &amp;amp; Jira = &amp;lt;3</b>      |

### Additional information

Parameters used in this function

| Parameter | Input (data type) | Description     |
|-----------|-------------------|-----------------|
| text      | <div>TEXT</div>   | Any given text. |

### Output

This function returns a 

TEXT
