

status()

This function returns the **status name** for a given **ID**.

syntax

```
status(id) #Output: Text
```

Examples

Parser expression	Description
<code>status(1)</code>	This example returns the name of the status with the ID 1 , e.g. Open

Additional information

Parameters used in this function



Parameter	Input (data type)	Description
id	<input type="text" value="NUMBER"/>	A valid status ID.

Output


This function returns a .

If there is no status with the given ID, the function returns .

Use this function to ensure expressions will continue to work after **renaming** statuses.

Will continue to work after status name update 	Will fail after status name update 
<code>%{issue.status} = status(1)</code>	<code>%{issue.status} = "In Progress"</code>
