

resolution()

This function returns the **name** of the **resolution** with a given **ID**.

Syntax

```
resolution(id) #Output: Text
```

Examples

Parser expression	Description
<pre>resolution(10000)</pre>	This example returns a text with the corresponding name of the resolution with the ID 10000 e.g. Won't Fix

Additional information

Parameters used in this function



Parameter	Input (data type)	Description
id	<input type="text" value="NUMBER"/>	A valid ID of a resolution.

Output


This function returns a .

If there is no resolution with the given ID, the function returns .

Use this function to ensure expressions will continue to work after **renaming** resolutions:

Will continue to work after resolution name update 	Will fail after resolution name update 
<pre>%{issue.resolution} = resolution(10000)</pre>	<pre>%{issue.resolution} = "Won't Fix"</pre>
