

project()

This function returns the **key** of the **project** with a given **ID**.

Syntax

```
project(id) #Output: Text
```

Examples

Parser expression	Description
<code>project(10000)</code>	This example returns a text with the corresponding key of the project with the ID 10000 e.g. DEV

Additional information

Parameters used in this function


Parameter	Input (data type)	Description
id	<input type="text" value="NUMBER"/>	A valid project ID.

Output


This function returns a .

If there is no project with the given ID, the function returns .

Use this function to ensure expressions will continue to work after **renaming** projects:

Will continue to work after project name update 	Will fail after project name update 
<code>%{issue.project.key} = project(10000)</code>	<code>%{issue.project.key} = "CRM"</code>
