

filterByProjectCategory()

This function filters a given **issue list** by the provided **project categories**.

Syntax

`filterByProjectCategory(issueList, projectCategories)` #Output: Issue list

Examples

Parser expression	Description
<code>filterByProjectCategory(linkedIssues(), "Development, Production")</code>	This example returns the issue list of linked issues belonging to projects in categories Development or Production. To achieve this, the following functions are used: <code>linkedIssues()</code>
<code>filterByProjectCategory(linkedIssues("blocks"), "Customer support")</code>	This example returns an issue list of blocked issues belonging to projects in category Customer support. To achieve this, the following functions are used: <code>linkedIssues()</code>
<code>filterByProjectCategory(linkedIssues(), projectCategory(%{issue.project.key}))</code>	This example returns an issue list of linked issue that are in the same project category like the current issue. To achieve this, the following functions are used: <code>linkedIssues()</code> <code>projectCategory()</code>

Additional information

Parameters used in this function

Parameter	Input (data type)	Description
issueList	ISSUE LIST	Any given issue list. Usually this value is retrieved from a function (e.g. <code>linkedIssues()</code> or <code>subtasks()</code>).
projectCategories	TEXT	A text with a project category. Several categories can be provided as comma separated list.
