

getNumber()

This function returns the value stored in a **number variable**, which was previously created using the [setNumber\(\)](#) function.

Syntax

getNumber(variableName) #Output: Number

Examples

Expression parser	Description
getNumber("myNumber")	This example returns the value stored in the variable named "myNumber" , e.g.: 3

Parameter	Input (data type)	Description
variableName	TEXT	The name of the stored variable.
