

setString()

This function creates a variable for storing a **text** value, and directly **sets a value**.

This value will be immediately returned and can be accessed by the [getString\(\)](#) function afterwards **within the same expression**.

Syntax

```
setString(variableName, value) #Output: Text
```

Examples

Expression parser	Description
<pre>setString("myText", "Hello World!")</pre>	This example creates the variable " myText ", sets the value " Hello World! " and returns it accordingly.

Additional information

Parameters used in this function

Parameter	Input (data type)	Description
variableName	TEXT	A text for the variable name.
value	TEXT	The text value to be stored.

Output

This function returns a TEXT

To **retrieve** the value stored in the variable, use the function [getString\(\)](#) **within the same expression**.
