

getString()

This function returns the value stored in a **text variable**, which was previously created using the [setList\(\)](#) function.

Syntax

```
getString(variableName) #Output: Text
```

Examples

Expression parser	Description
getString("myString")	This example returns the value stored in "myString", e.g.: "Hello World!"

Additional information

Parameters used in this function

Parameter	Input (data type)	Description
variableName	TEXT	The name of the stored variable.

Output

This function returns a

TEXT

To return the value you **must have created** the **variable** before, using the [setString\(\)](#) function **within the same expression**.
