

# getNumber()

This function returns the value stored in a **number variable**, which was previously created using the [setNumber\(\)](#) function.

## Syntax

```
getNumber(variableName) #Output: Number
```

## Examples

Expression parser	Description
getNumber( "myNumber" )  3	This example returns the value stored in the variable named "myNumber", e.g.:  3

## Additional information

Parameters used in this function

Parameter	Input (data type)	Description
variableName	TEXT	The name of the stored variable.

## Output

This function returns a NUMBER

To return the value you **must have created** the **variable** before, using the [setNumber\(\)](#) function **within the same expression**.
