

setStringList()

This function creates a variable for storing a **text list**, and directly **sets** the **values**.

This value will be immediately returned and can be accessed by the [getStringList\(\)](#) function afterwards **within the same expression**.

Syntax

```
setStringList(variableName, textList) #Output: Text list
```

Examples

Expression parser	Description
<pre>setStringList("myTextList", ["Hello", "World"])</pre>	This example creates the variable "myTextList", sets the values ["Hello", "World"] and returns it accordingly.

Additional information

Parameters used in this function

Parameter	Input (data type)	Description
variableName	TEXT	A text for the variable name.
numberList	ISSUE LIST	Any given text list.

Output

This function returns a

TEXT LIST

To **retrieve** the value stored in the variable, use the function [getStringList\(\)](#) **within the same expression**.
