

abs()

This function returns the absolute value of **the given number**. If **number**>=0 it returns **the number**, otherwise it returns the **number multiplied with -1**.

Syntax

abs(number) #Output: Number

Examples

Parser expression	Description
abs(2)	This example returns: 2.0
abs(-2)	This example returns: 2.0
abs(0)	This example returns: 0.0
