

# Create issue (use cases)

The [Create issue](#) post function automatically **creates a single issue** or **sub-task** in **any project**.

The issue type can be selected from a list of **all available issue** and **sub-task issue** types in the system (excluding next-gen projects).

**Field values** can be **inherited** or **manually be set** using the [JWT expression editor](#).
