

# floor()

This function returns the floor value. i.e. The **greatest mathematical integer** that is less than or equal to **the given number**.

## Syntax

`floor(number)` #Output: Number

## Examples

Parser expression	Description
<code>%{floor(-1.3)}</code>	This example returns: <b>-2</b>
<code>%{floor(0)}</code>	This example returns: <b>0</b>
<code>%{floor(2.3)}</code>	This example returns: <b>2</b>
