## dayOfTheWeek()

This function returns the day of the week of any given timestamp.

## Syntax

```
dayOfTheWeek(timestamp, timeZone) #Output: Number
```


## Examples

| Parser expression | Description |
| :--- | :--- |
| \% \{dayOfTheWeek ( issue. dueDate $\},$ <br> RUN_AS_LOCAL) \} | This example will return the day part of the issue's due date. |
|  | If the due date was set to April 21st, 2020 00:00 the output would be 3 since <br> this day is a Tuesday. |

Parameters used in this function

| Parameter | Input (data type) | Description |
| :---: | :---: | :--- |
| timestamp | NUMBER | The parameter must be a valid timestamp. Usually this value is retrieved from a field (e.g. due date, created <br> date). |
| timeZone | TEXT | The time zone used for the calculation. |

Days might depend on the time zone - it might be Sunday on the west coast of the US while at the same time it's already Monday in Australia.

## Output

This function returns a $\qquad$ where Sunday =1, Monday =2, $\ldots$ Saturday $=7$.
