

# lastDayOfTheMonth()

This function returns a **number** representing the **timestamp** for the last day of the month of a given **timestamp** in a specific **time zone**.

The timestamp returns 00:00 i.e., the very beginning of the last day.

## Syntax

```
lastDayOfTheMonth(timestamp, timeZone) #Output: Number
```

## Examples

Parser expression	Description
<pre>lastDayOfTheMonth(2020/02/05 11:31, LOCAL)</pre>	This example returns: <b>2020/02/28 00:00</b> .
<pre>lastDayOfTheMonth({issue.created}, LOCAL)</pre>	This example returns the timestamp of the last day of the month an issue was <b>created</b> .

## Additional information

Parameters used in this function

Parameter	Input (data type)	Description
timestamp	NUMBER	The parameter must be valid <b>timestamp</b> . Usually this value is retrieved from a <b>field</b> (e.g. due date, created date).
timeZone	TIMEZONE	The <b>time zone</b> used for the calculation.

**Work days** might depend on the **time zone** - it might be Sunday on the west coast of the US while at the same time it's already Monday in Australia.
