≡ 1	 <b>Blocker</b>	Blocks development and/or testing work, production could not run.		1 scheme	Edit Delete
≡ 2	 <b>Critical</b>	Crashes, loss of data, severe memory leak.		1 scheme	Edit Delete
≡ 3	 <b>Major</b>	Major loss of function.		1 scheme	Edit Delete
≡ 4	 <b>Minor</b>	Minor loss of function, or other problem where easy workaround is present.		1 scheme	Edit Delete
≡ 5	 <b>Trivial</b>	Cosmetic problem like misspelt words or misaligned text.		1 scheme	Edit Delete
