The move page action | Drag & drop

Moving pages has never been easier. Either use the move action or drag & drop pages across page trees - and across spaces!

You can also move multiple pages at once using the Bulk move pages action.

## The move page action

Right-click on the desired page or hover over the page and click on the ellipsis menu "..."



Select the Move action.



Select the target space.



Define a reference page.

The reference page indicates the relative target location of the page you want to move. The **positioning options** (next step) will define its final location.



Define the final location of the page you want to move relative to the defined reference page. Select among these options:

Option	Description
Insert as a child page	The moved page will be inserted as a <b>child page of the reference page</b> .
Insert on the same hierarchy level after reference page	The moved page will be inserted directly <b>after the reference page</b> on the same hierarchy level
Insert on the same hierarchy level before reference page	The moved page will be inserted directly <b>before the reference page</b> on the same hierarchy level



Click on Move.
