Moving pages has never been easier. Either use the move action or [drag & drop](#) pages across **page trees** - and **across spaces**!

You can also move multiple pages at once using the [Bulk move pages](#) action.

The move page action

Right-click on the desired page or **hover** over the page and click on the **ellipsis** menu "..."

2

Select the **Move** action.

3

Select the **target space**.

4

Define a **reference page**.

The reference page indicates the relative target location of the page you want to move. The **positioning options** (next step) will define its final location.

5

Define the final location of the page you want to move relative to the defined **reference page**. Select among these options:

Option	Description
Insert as a child page	The moved page will be inserted as a child page of the reference page .
Insert on the same hierarchy level after reference page	The moved page will be inserted directly after the reference page on the same hierarchy level..
Insert on the same hierarchy level before reference page	The moved page will be inserted directly before the reference page on the same hierarchy level..

Click on **Move**.

Drag & drop

As simple as it sounds! Drag & drop pages to **move** or **reorder** them.

You can even drag & drop pages **across spaces!**
