Moving pages has never been easier. Either use the move action or [drag & drop](#) pages across **page trees** - and **across spaces**!

You can also move multiple pages at once using the [Bulk move pages](#) action.

## The move page action

**Right-click** on the desired page or **hover** over the page and click on the **ellipsis** menu "..."

2

Select the **Move** action.

3

Select the **target space**.

4

Define a **reference page**.

The reference page indicates the relative target location of the page you want to move. The **positioning options** (next step) will define its final location.

5

Define the final location of the page you want to move relative to the defined **reference page**. Select among these options:

Option	Description
Insert as a child page	The moved page will be inserted as a <b>child page of the reference page</b> .
Insert on the same hierarchy level after reference page	The moved page will be inserted directly <b>after the reference page</b> on the same hierarchy level..
Insert on the same hierarchy level before reference page	The moved page will be inserted directly <b>before the reference page</b> on the same hierarchy level..

Click on **Move**.

## Drag & drop

As simple as it sounds! Drag & drop pages to **move** or **reorder** them.

You can even drag & drop pages **across spaces!**
