

# month()

This function returns the **month** part of a timestamp based on a given **time zone** (represented by a number from 1 to 12).

## Syntax

```
month(timestamp, timeZone) #Output: Number
```

## Examples

Parser expression	Description
<pre>%{month({issue.created}, RUN_AS_LOCAL)}</pre>	<p>This example returns the <b>month</b> of the <b>issue creation date</b> as a number.</p> <p><b>i</b> Given an issue that was created on <b>March 25th, 2020 23:15:30</b>, the returned value is <b>3</b>.</p>
<pre>%{month(stringToDate("2020-01-01 00:30", "Europe/Berlin"), "UTC")}</pre>	<p>This example returns the <b>month</b> part of the <b>given date</b>, the timezone is <b>UTC</b>.</p> <p><b>i</b> Due to the time zone <b>UTC</b>, the output will be <b>12</b>.</p>

## Additional information

Parameters used in this function

Parameter	Input (data type)	Description
timestamp	NUMBER	The parameter must be valid <b>timestamp</b> . Usually this value is retrieved from a <b>field</b> (e.g. due date, created date).
timeZone	TEXT	The <b>time zone</b> used for the calculation.

This function returns a **NUMBER**
