

minute()

This function returns the **minutes** part of a timestamp based on a given time zone.

Syntax

`minute(timestamp, timeZone) #Output: Number`

Examples

Parser expression	Description
<code>%{minute({issue.created}, RUN_AS_LOCAL)}</code>	This example returns the minute part of the issue creation date  If the issue was created on March 25th, 2020 23:15:30 the output would be 15.
<code>%{minute(stringToDate("2020-01-01 00:30:00", "YYYY-MM hh:mm:ss"), "UTC")}</code>	This example uses the time zone UTC , it returns: 30

Parameters used in this function

Parameter	Input (data type)	Description
timestamp	NUMBER	The parameter must be valid timestamp . Usually this value is retrieved from a field (e.g. due date, created date).
timeZone	TEXT	The time zone used for the calculation.
