

filterByStatus()

This function filters the given **issue list** by the provided **statuses**.

Syntax

```
filterByStatus(issueList, statuses) #Output: Issue list
```

Examples

Parser expression	Description
<pre>%{filterByStatus(linkedIssues("is blocked by"), "Open, Reopened, In Progress")}</pre>	<p>This example returns the issue list of blocking issues in statuses Open, Reopened or In Progress.</p> <p>To achieve this, the following functions are used:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• linkedIssues()
<pre>%{filterByStatus(subtasks(), "Done")}</pre>	<p>This example returns an issue list with all sub-tasks that are in status Done.</p> <p>To achieve this, the following functions are used:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• subtasks()

Additional information

Parameters used in this function

Parameter	Input (data type)	Description
issueList	ISSUE LIST	Any given issue list. Usually this value is retrieved from a function (e.g. linkedIssues() or subtasks()).
statuses	TEXT	Any given status name. Several statuses can be provided as comma separated list.
