

resolution()

This function returns the **name** of the **resolution** with a given **ID**.

Syntax

```
resolution(id) #Output: Text
```

Examples

Parser expression	Description
<code>%{resolution(10000)}</code>	This example returns a text with the corresponding name of the resolution with the ID 10000 , e.g. Won't Fix

Additional information

Parameters used in this function

Parameter	Input (data type)	Description
id	NUMBER	A valid ID of a resolution.

Output

This function returns a **TEXT**

If there is no resolution with the given ID, the function returns **NULL**

Use this function to ensure expressions will continue to work after **renaming** resolutions:

Will continue to work after resolution name update ✓

```
%{issue.resolution} = resolution(10000)
```

Will fail after resolution name update ✗

```
%{issue.resolution} = "Won't Fix"
```
