

# projectPropertyExists()

This function returns `true` if there is a project property with a given name in the current issue's project.

## Syntax

```
projectPropertyExists(propertyName) #Output: Boolean
```

## Examples

Parser expression	Description
<pre>projectPropertyExists ( "maxNumberOfReopenings" )</pre>	<p>This example returns:</p> <p><b>true</b></p> <p>if there is a <b>project property</b> like <code>{maxNumberOfReopenings=x}</code> in the description of the current issue's project.</p>

## Output

This function returns a

Variant where you can additionally define **project key**.

## Syntax

```
projectPropertyExists(propertyName, projectKey) #Output: Boolean
```

## Examples

Parser expression	Description
-------------------	-------------

```
projectPropertyExists  
( "maxNumberOfReopenings", "CRM" )
```

This example returns

**true**

if there is a project property like **{maxNumberOfReopenings=x}** in the description of the project with key **CRM**.
