

# Migrate 'Send email'

The [Send email post function of JWT DC](#) is also available for [JWT Cloud](#), with minor differences in terms of parameters and options.

The table below shows the detailed mapping between JWT DC and JWT Cloud.

		Selected users	Instead of adding email addresses manually (like in the option <b>Set recipients manually</b> in JWT DC), this option in JWT Cloud can be used to add certain users as recipients.
