sumUp can be used within the **Issue Navigator** to display a calculation row at the bottom of the issue list.

When activated, a result will be displayed for each field in the navigator that has a [calculation rule](#) configured.

If no [calculation rules](#) are configured, the calculation row won't be displayed. Also select **List View** and select the correct **Columns**.

If the **permanent calculation is not activated**, the calculation row will be **removed** every time the page reloads.


Activating the calculation row in Jira's Filter Result gadget

By default, the calculation row won't be displayed in the filter results gadget.

It has to be **manually activated** for the filter used in the gadget.

To activate the calculation row for the filter used in the gadget, head over to the **Issue Navigator** and click on the **cogwheel** in the upper left corner.
