

userDisplayName()

This function returns the **display name** for a given Atlassian account ID. In case the given text is not a valid Atlassian account ID, an empty text is returned.

Syntax

```
userDisplayName(accountId) #Output: Text
```

Examples

Parser expression	Description
<pre>%{userDisplayName(%{system.currentUser})}</pre>	This example returns the display name of the current user, e.g.: Bob Smith

Syntax

```
userDisplayName(accountIdList) #Output: Text list
```

Examples

Parser expression	Description
<pre>%{userDisplayName(toStringList(%{issue.watcher}))}</pre>	<p>This example returns the display names of all watchers. To achieve this, the following function is used:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• toStringList()

```
%{userDisplayName([ "557058:145e0983-5707-439c-80e4-1160dd57f142" ,  
%{issue.reporter}])}}
```

This example returns the display names of the given **two users**, e.g.:

Bob Smith, Mary Jones
